Phil Neuhoff has secured the case favors for cases this year.

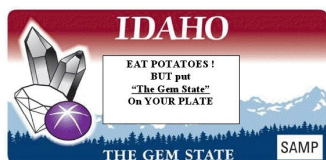
Tony Griffin will be chair for the "Display Cases" this year. Be sure to contact Tony to reserve your case for the upcoming show.

When Harry sold his garages they decided to move to Parker, Arizona. Joyce died and Harry was not able to take care of himself so he was move to a nursing home. Harry was not a nursing home person but all his attempts to leave were aborted, so he called the Police to come get him out as he was being held captive. Not once but twice.)

The Board decided to invite other clubs to display outstanding displays that they had and make a special display of them.

Letters of Thanks from Neil Armstrong for the necklace his wife had received was put in the record book along with the one he sent the Governor thanking him for making him a member of our club.

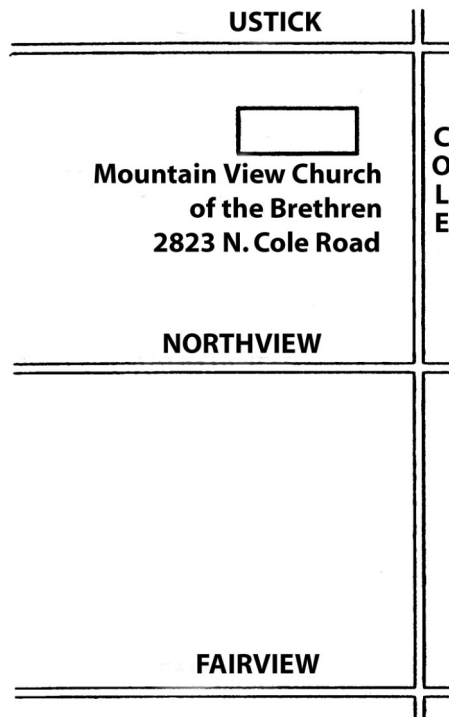
